HEMORRHOID BANDING PROCEDURE

The hemorrhoid banding session includes the placement of a small rubber band around the base of one hemorrhoid. There are usually 3 banding sessions required at 2 to 3 week intervals. A final check-up may be scheduled 4 – 6 weeks after the 3rd banding session.

PLEASE STOP ASPIRIN 1 DAY BEFORE THE SCHEDULED BANDING

PLEASE STOP COUMADIN AND PLAVIX 5 DAYS BEFORE THE SCHEDULED BANDING

ON THE DAY OF THE PROCEDURE:

There are no dietary restrictions or bowel preparation required

Continue all medications as usual, except blood thinners
